


Computer Projection Using MirrorOp

****You need MirrorOp installed from the Managed Software Center to use Enzo****

1. Turn on the projector. (If detailed directions are needed, see the quick sheet for HDMI Projection Setup.)


The Enzo interface image should appear on the screen. If you don't see it, press the Input button on the keypad once. Wait until the next display message appears. Keep pressing and waiting until you see to the Enzo screen on HDMI 1. Be sure to press the buttons gently.

If the green screen for Enzo on HDMI 1 does not show up, see Troubleshooting #3 on this page.



2. Open MirrorOp (the program can be found in your Application folder if it is not already in your dock).

- Put the cursor in the Input hostname of IP field at the bottom of the window
- Add the IP address you see on the Enzo screen
- Click Connect
- Enter the Code you also see on the Enzo screen
- Click OK



- The MirrorOp window shortens up a bit and you need to click the '>' right arrow button at the top of the window to start mirroring your computer
- You can move this window anywhere on your screen that is convenient.



3. If you don't hear sound when expected, make sure the Apple System Preferences for Sound are on Soundflower2 for both Input and Output and that Input volume is all the way up. (System Preferences can be found under the Apple in the menu bar in the upper left of the screen.)

You can control the volume in MirrorOp with the volume controls on your laptop using the keyboard keys, the Volume icon in the menu bar or in the video window itself.

If not hearing any sound, see troubleshooting #1 and #2.

Troubleshooting

1. The first time you try to use MirrorOp, you may find the volume doesn't work. If so, make sure the volume is all the way up on the Enzo keyboard.

2. If you are still not hearing any sound, go to the wall keypad and press the Channel up button once. Wait until the screen changes, then press the 'Esc' button on your Enzo keyboard.

3. If you are on HDMI 1 and searching for the green Enzo screen with the IP and Code but see one of these instead

- a black screen with only the word 'Enzo' on it
- a scrolling message across the bottom
- the Roosevelt red screen image

Press 'Esc' on the Enzo keyboard to get back to the Enzo screen.
